



## WSCO Certification Guidelines

### A certificate with an WSCO title has to include the following:

1. the correct title of the qualification and the information regarding the amount of face to face training according to the WSCO respective curriculum in days and hours:
  - "**Beginner, WSCO**" (or "Systemic Constellation Beginner, WSCO"): 160 hrs/22 days (30 hrs/4 days + the entrance qualification of 130 hrs/18 days "NLP Practitioner, IN" or comparable qualification) \*1
  - "**Foundation, WSCO**" (or "Systemic Constellation Foundation, WSCO"): 190 hrs/26 days (30 hrs/4 days + the entrance qualification "Beginner, WSCO") \*2
  - "**Advanced, WSCO**" (or "Systemic Constellation Advanced, WSCO"):: 225 hrs/31 days (35 hrs./5 days + the entrance qualification "Foundation, WSCO") \*3
  - "**Master, WSCO**" (or "Systemic Constellation Master, WSCO"):: 335 hrs/46 days (110 hrs./15 days + the entrance qualification "Advanced, WSCO") \*4
  - "**Professional, WSCO**" (or "Systemic Constellation Professional, WSCO"): 410 hrs/56 days (75 hrs./10 days + the entrance qualification "Master, WSCO") \*5
  - "**Trainer, WSCO**" (or "Systemic Constellation Trainer, WSCO"): 540 hrs/74 days (130 hrs./18 days + the entrance qualification "Professional, WSCO") \*6
2. the date of the first and last day of the training
3. a statement that all WSCO guidelines have been met
4. the WSCO seal (sticker with WSCO logo and seal number)
5. the signature of the "Systemic Constellation Master Trainer, WSCO"

### Please note that if you use an WSCO title on a certificate, an WSCO seal is required.

\*1: If for "Beginner, WSCO" only the Basic module time of 30 hrs./4 days is used on the certificate, then it is needed to include, that the entry requirements for this qualification is a valid "NLP Practitioner, IN" certificate (or a comparable from WSCO accepted qualification).

\*2: If for "Foundation, WSCO" only the Intermediate module time of 30 hrs./4 days is used on the certificate, then it is needed to include, that the entry requirements for this qualification is a valid "Beginner, WSCO" certificate.

\*3: If for "Advanced, WSCO" only the Advanced module time of 45 hrs./5 days is used on the certificate, then it is needed to include, that the entry requirements for this qualification are a valid "Foundation, WSCO" certificate.

\*4: If for "Master, WSCO" only the Master module time of 110 hrs./15 days is used on the certificate, then it is needed to include, that the entry requirements for this qualification is a valid "Advanced, WSCO" certificate.

\*5: If for "Professional, WSCO" only the Intermediate module time of 75 hrs./10 days is used on the certificate, then it is needed to include, that the entry requirements for this qualification is a valid "Master, WSCO" certificate.

\*6: If for "Trainer, WSCO" only the Trainer module time of 130 hrs./18 days is used on the certificate, then it is needed to include, that the entry requirements for this qualification are a valid "Professional, WSCO"

certificate. A 18 days / 130 hrs. "NLP Trainer, IN" training can be accepted as comparable to a "Trainer, WSCO" training.

## Optional

**1. Training content for the qualification:** We highly recommend to list the complete trained main content and the complete amount of training hours and days that is needed for the certified qualification in Constellation on the backside of the certificate or on a separate signed document.

**2. Entry Requirements with not WSCO sealed certificates:** Certificates with a comparable amount of face to face training from a Systemic Constellation Master Trainer with comparable qualification background as a "Systemic Constellation Master Trainer, WSCO" can be accepted as entry requirement as well. In case of any ambiguity or uncertainties please contact the WSCO President in charge or the WSCO Office.

**3. For stating the academic value of an WSCO sealed certificate the following statement can be used:** "Because of the high quality of this training it may be recognized as ECTS credit points in academic studies in psychology with a focus on Systemic Constellation."

## More Details regarding WSCO Certification and Training Standards:

A training hour has 60 minutes. Brakes longer than 30 minutes are not counted as training time. A training group has at least 6 members (counted without assistants or "Master Trainer, WSCO"). We highly recommend assistants for trainings bigger than 10 participants. An WSCO certification training with WSCO sealed certificates (sticker with WSCO logo and seal number) has to be conducted at least 80% of the time by an approved "Master Trainer, WSCO ". The remaining up to 20% of the training can be conducted under his supervision and responsibility. **WSCO seals:** For ordering WSCO seals please use the login area. In this online process you can define the correct address where the seals should be sent, the system sends you the invoice immediately, you can pay immediately, and everything goes faster this way. A seal costs 15 €. The WSCO pays the shipment. Every WSCO seal consists of the WSCO logo with a unique number.

## Free membership with a sealed certificate

We highly recommend that you motivate your training participants to become a member for free. No admission fee and no yearly membership fee. Really totally free of cost. Registration has many advantages. First of all, it supports your marketing for all the members who come from you are listed in your profile. Your participants can register individual one by one at [www.wSCO.online/application](http://www.wSCO.online/application) This application process is time consuming for your participants and requires them to upload their certificate for validation. Therefore, we recommend a more easily approach to register all of your participants at once without the need to upload individual certificates. Its quick and easy.

## There are 2 methods to register all of your participants in one step:

**Method A** (recommended): Let your participants register with a simple magic link when you hand out the sealed certificates directly at the end of your training.

**Method B** (not recommended): Group Registration per E-Mail some days after the end of training.
