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WSCO Standards & Curriculum for: "Systemic Constellation Master, WSCO"

110 hrs/15 days of Systemic Constellation Master training

Entrance qualification: "Systemic Constellation Practitioner, WSCO"

Duration & procedure of the training of: "Systemic Constellation Master, WSCO"

- A minimum of 322 hours face-to-face training in a minimum of 45 days (110 hrs./15 days Systemic Constellation Master training + the entrance qualification "Systemic Constellation Practitioner, WSCO")
- "Systemic Constellation Practitioner, WSCO is a prerequisite which is 212 hrs/30 days, In this case the module "Systemic Constellation Master, WSCO" training has at least 110 hrs/15 days. Which when we add the Systemic Constellation Master WSCO, all will sum up to 322 hrs/45 days
- Case reflections of Systemic Constellation applications as Systemic Constellation Master and as client along with a written and a practical test
- Facilitating minimum of 15 Constellations within group basis + 5 one-on-one settings with a submitted report on all
- Recorded one Group constellation + one one-on-one setting sessions are required to be submitted for graduation

Training content of: "Systemic Constellation Master, WSCO"

- for the first 212 hours / 32 days please see the content of "Systemic Constellation Practitioner, WSCO"
- **For the 110 hours / 15 days please cover the following content in addition:**
- A deeper engagement, knowledge and understanding of the philosophy and principles that underpin systemic constellation work.
- Special dynamics (e.g. families, illness, ...)
- Combining the technology of the work and the spirit of creativity, to produce evocative images for Facilitators and their clients.
- Recognizing the client's primary and secondary centers of knowing (head, heart, body) and tell the story that meets their availability.
- Addressing the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats (our own constellation 'SWOT' analysis!) that are present in our work now, and the next step needed in our systemic practice.
- The Shadow realms and their main archetypes, background and major contexts of Shadow
